

Editorial Preface

The *Romanian Journal of Analytic Philosophy* (RJAP) is edited by the Romanian Society of Analytic Philosophy, a non-profit association affiliated to the European Society of Analytic Philosophy. RJAP is a journal of wide topical opening, hosting contributions from many areas of philosophy: metaphysics, logic, epistemology, philosophy of science, philosophy of mind, philosophy of language, political and moral philosophy, history of philosophy, etc. The fundamental requirement of RJAP is the emphasis on discursive clarity, explicit use of arguments and respect for scientific thinking.

One of the main sources of contributions to the journal is the yearly International Colloquium in Analytic Philosophy. This is an international event, organized on particular topics, which brings together leading specialists of the respective fields. The colloquium galvanizes philosophical reflection of analytic style in Romania and in the neighboring countries. The current inaugural issue mainly consists of a selection of texts presented at the third edition of the colloquium, which took place in May of 2005 under the title “Mind, Language, and Knowledge”. For the coming issues, however, the journal will also host peer-reviewed uninvited submissions.

The editors thereby hope to open an ecumenical dialogue in analytic philosophy and a forum in which the voice of Romanian philosophers may also be heard.
