

Notes for Contributors

The articles should be mailed or emailed to the Editor or an Associate Editor. They should not be more than 8000 words. An abstract of 150-200 words should be included.

References should be indicated in the typescript by giving the author's name, with the year of publication in parentheses. If several papers by the same author and from the same year are cited, the letter a, b, c, d etc. Should be added after the year of publication. The references should be listed in full at the end of the paper, according to the following example:

- Gigerenzer, Gerd (2000), *Adaptive Thinking. Rationality in the Real World*, Oxford: Oxford University Press
Harsanyi, John C. (1986), "Advances in Understanding Rational Behaviour", in Elster, John (ed.), *Rational Choice*, Oxford: Basil Blackwell
Papineau, David (1990), "Causes and mixed probabilities", in *International Studies in the Philosophy of Science*, 4, pp. 79-98

Titles of journals should not be abbreviated.

Copyright. It is a condition of publication that authors vest copyright in their articles, including abstracts, in the Romanian Society of Analytic Philosophy (RSAP). Authors may use the article elsewhere after publication, without prior permission from RSAP, provided that acknowledgment is given to the journal as the original source of publication.
